Give to Grow Breaks Record \$265,659 Raised in one week

The fifth Give to Grow was a weeklong challenge that resulted in 611 gifts totaling \$185,659.16. Add to this a challenge bonus of \$80,000. As a result, \$265,659 was the total given to the nonprofits!

The challenge bonus was provided by LaVon and Erma Wenger, Kent and Donna Saylor, Paul and Betsy Tedman, Morrill and Janes Bank, Wenger Manufacturing and one anonymous donor. GSCF is grateful for their generosity.

Several nonprofits, who were competing for the matching bonus dollars, agreed with Steve Huenke who said, "It was energizing to watch the leaderboard totals grow!" Huneke is a volunteer with the top fund in this year's group of 45 organizations that participated, Neighbor-2-Neighbor. Following Neighbor-2-Neighbor which brought in \$23,189.46, was \$21,951.55 for the Friends of the Mary Cotton Library fund and \$21,254.48 given to the Apostolic Christian Home. The Main Event and the Sabetha Hospital Health Foundation came in a close fourth and fifth place.


